From the millions of Bible-believing Christians, martyred during the dark ages, you can hear an echo in the Declaration of Independence,

"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness. --That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed,..."

In studying the teachings of Jesus in the Bible, the signers found the greatest moral teachings in the world. These principles gave our founding fathers the ability to form a new kind of government. This Biblical idea that the Creator had created all men equal with rights was revolu-tionary. These were rights that could not be changed by councils, churches, mobs or governments, no matter how powerful they were. These were rights, not privileges. The founding fathers accurately concluded, from the teachings of Jesus, that governments were ordained to protect these rights.



Abigale Adams was the wife of the second president and mother of the sixth president. So great was her influence that she is sometimes considered to have been a Founder of the United States. For instance, with almost prophetic insight she said that slavery was evil and a threat to American Democracy. In a letter to her husband, on the signing the Declaration of

Independence, we can hear the influence of the Bible on her thinking, "May the foundation of our new constitution, be justice, Truth and Righteousness. Like the wise Man's house may it be founded upon those Rocks and then neither storms or tempests will overthrow it."
