Emancipation Proclamation!

-The Story Behind David Bolduc



January 1 is the one day in the year when we can leave the old year behind and move on with a clean slate. On January 1, 1863, Abraham Lincoln issued an executive order to free slaves in areas held by the Confederacy. Many things happened in the previous year that led up to this point. One thing that weighed heavily on his mind was the death of his beloved son Willie.

Both Tad and Willie were very precocious, getting into everything. They enjoyed terrorizing the staff and even had a pet goat pull them in a wagon around the White House. The water source for the White House was the polluted Potomac River; it affected everyone that drew water from it. Both boys contracted typhoid fever. Tad had a mild case, but Willie's case was severe. Willie died on Feb. 20, 1862. The President and Mary Lincoln were deeply impacted by Willie's death, Mary more so, but the President often shut himself in a private room and mourned his beloved son.

Lincoln had long hated slavery ever since the first time he and his friend Allen Gentry made a trip down the Mississippi hauling a load of produce to New Orleans. They sold their load and then explored the city. That's when Lincoln saw first-hand the horrible slave markets and it left a marked impression on him for the rest of his life.

On September 22, 1862, five days after the battle of Antietam, Lincoln said, "I made a solemn vow before God, that if General Lee were driven back from Pennsylvania, I would crown the result with the declaration of freedom for the slaves."

Webster's Dictionary says emancipation means to free from restraint, control, or the power of another, especially to free from bondage.

Sin holds us in bondage, especially guilt from memories of things we have done in our past that we wish could be erased. We cannot run away from them, and the enemy of souls has a way of bringing to our minds those events,

He washes our sins away with His blood. He cleanses us from sin and the healing process begins immediately. But, just like our human nature is inclined, we pick at the wound or even worse, we dive back into the thing that caused the guilt in the first place. Does He turn us away at that point? Never!

Like the song says, "There IS Power in the Blood." When tempted to sin, turn back to the Lord and plead for His emancipation from the bondage of sin!

Although Antietam was not a decisive victory for the North, Lee took his troops back to Virginia and Lincoln saw this as a sign of Divine Providence.

When Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation, it's reported that he said, "I never, in my life, felt more certain that I was doing right, than I do in signing this paper."

Many had urged him to free the slaves much earlier, but he saw that such a move would be short-lived. He waited until the issue would forever be resolved. By the leading of God, Lincoln was able to re-unite the nation where all men and women would be free.
