How I Became a New Mother in My 50's By Laurie Snyman

To think about bringing another son or daughter into our family was never considered. My only daughter has been married for several years. We certainly had no clue about it when we invited



a young man home for Thanksgiving dinner. He was very thin and appeared like he could use a good home-cooked meal!

Carlot was in his 30's, from Haiti and studying music at Michigan State University. Although he had suffered an accident in childhood and only had one arm, he was a professional trumpeter, playing concerts all over the US. We thoroughly enjoyed his visit to our home and I asked him to accompany me to some churches on weekends to play music where I was speaking. His music was inspiring and appreciated by all who heard him, and I was touched by his childhood story. It was of incredible hardship, the murder of his mother and the abandonment of his father, but his resilience and faith in God brought him through. God had performed miracles in his young life, and Carlot has donated much of his time to help handicapped children learn music.

Carlot miraculously came to this country only one week before the great Haitian earthquake that took down the buildings of his school AND the students in those buildings. As he shared his story, my heart was full of love for him. His story was so fascinating and such a picture of God's love that I wrote a book about him, *From Trauma to Triumph, The Carlot Dorve Story*, available on Amazon.

We helped him get his driver's license and made sure he had a car. He started to call me "mother friend", as the word 'mother' was reserved for our daughter. But, when they were together at a family dinner one night and each kept calling

It appears that Mary was already at the wedding feast when Jesus and His disciples accepted the invitation. When Mary saw there was a lack of wine, she immediately brought it to Jesus' attention. He gently reminded her that His time had not yet come for His life mission to be completely revealed. She accepted that but also hoped He would leave a hint as to what His mission would



be, so she told the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it." John 2:5 NKJV. Jesus told the servants to fill the pots with water. Verse 7 says, "... they filled them to the brim".

Notice, Mary didn't leave anything lacking when she gave the directions to the servants and the servants didn't leave anything lacking since they filled the pots up to the brim. Jesus saw the servants' obedience and His mother's faith along with the need of those at the feast, so He blessed them and asked the servants to do one more thing, draw from the pots and take it to the master of the feast.



me, I felt I heard God speak to me. "You have listened to people in your counseling practice bemoan they never felt they belonged in their family, because they were adopted, or a step child, or a half-brother/ sister, or from their parent's first family and not the newer family after a remarriage." I told my husband that I might tell Carlot if he wanted to call me 'mother', I would be comfortable with that. My husband was not. He said, "Are you trying to replace Carlot's mother? He loved her, and you can't be her substitute." But my mind was made up. I said to Carlot, "I would never try to replace your mother, but if you wish, you may call me 'mother'. He answered immediately, "Yes mother, I would love to call you Mother!"

My husband is much more cautious, and he thought it would be crazy at our age to adopt a young man into our family. Unbeknownst to me, the Lord was working on my husband. Several weeks later, at a Men of Faith Conference, the speaker recommended men take on the responsibility of mentoring young men for God, saying, "If God is calling you to do that, answer His call." My husband only told me about this recently and said, "I knew right away, that God was telling me we needed to have Carlot in our family."

Carlot was in England filming a commercial for the Paralympics. I received his long-distance call on his birthday. "Mother," he said, "I heard from Pastor Snyman today." I said with surprise, "Oh, really, what did he call you about?" Carlot continued, "He called and said, 'Happy birthday, Son.'" I took a breath in shock and I choked back tears. I asked quietly, "What did you say back?"



Carlot said, "I said, 'Thanks, Dad.'" That is how Carlot became a part of our family. And what a joy he has been to our lives these last 5 years. We have grown to love him as our own and wonder how we did without him all these years!! Motherhood is so sweet for me.


