Messianic Prophecies

While some people question whether Jesus was a real historical person, many accept that He was real. Others

declare that Jesus is a good man, a prophet who will return to earth, yet is not divine. Some profess Jesus to be a lesser god while the Father is the only eternal God.

The Bible is the most extensive record of Jesus' life on earth. Anyone who questions Jesus' identity, let alone his character, would do well to examine this Book which makes such amazing claims and truthfully records history.

The Bible not only records Jesus' life, but it also predicts many features and events of His life, including the character He would manifest while living on earth.

These prophecies include: the tribe from which He would descend (Gen. 49:10), several named members of His family line (Isa. 9:6-7, 11:1,11), when and where He would be born (Dan. 9:25, Mic. 5:2), a virgin birth (Is. 7:14), His time spent in Egypt as a child (Hos. 11:1), and how He dies (Is. 53:12), to name just eight prophecies! Scripture contains 60 major and 290 minor (smaller details) messianic prophecies, and Jesus Christ fulfilled all 350 of them!

Statisticians calculate the odds of one human being fulfilling even 8 of these prophecies is 1x 1017 (1 with 17 zeros). The odds of one person fulfilling 48 of these prophecies is 1x10157.[1] That's staggering! For perspective,



Is God Love?

Satan, the enemy, carefully conceals doubt in the 3 subtle suggestions to tempt Jesus in the wilderness. Satan's weapon was the game changing word, "IF". Those suggestions were as obvious to Jesus as a snowball in the face! The temptations of food, fame, and fortune found no resonating chord in His heart of Love for His Father.

I try to read Matt. 27:24-55 at least once a day. Ellen White counsels us to spend a thoughtful hour each day contemplating the life of Christ, especially the closing scenes on the cross. The three "IFs" in verses 40-43 stood out to me. Christ's heart was so full of love that self-preservation had no room there, even when tempted by people at the cross, ALL the hosts of evil angels, plus Satan himself.



While Jesus hung on the cross, Satan used the words of the mocking throng to tempt Him one last time using the word "IF". They misquoted Christ's statement about tearing down the temple and rebuilding it: if Jesus were to come down from the cross, He would not be able to rebuild His

body temple in three days by rising from the dead.

Second, the throng said, "He saved others, Himself He cannot save." The enemy used these words to mock Jesus. He knew Jesus could not save others if He saved Himself.

Third, the throng said scornfully, "He trusted in God, let God deliver Him now, if He will". The statement is blasphemy. Jesus' great love and trust in His Father, and His love for all of mankind, including the mocking throng, meant that coming down from the cross was not an option.

3ABN's founder, Danny Shelton's song is so fitting, "It Was Love". The song points out that the nails were not what kept Jesus on the cross. It was His great love for all mankind.

The enemy tries to make us think we are in the worst spot. He then tries to justify in our minds an "easy" way of escape that is contrary to God's will. What is really in my heart? How do I react when squeezed by the enemy? Like a toothpaste tube, only what is within me will come out. This year of COVID we are all learning things about ourselves we may not have known before. I have been pressed in many ways, and it wasn't always

2020 Tax Deductions

We've all been challenged these past few months, and we want to alert you to additional

giving opportunities. The CARES (Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act) on 3/27, offers more ways you can support Strong Tower Radio!

For tax year 2020 you can:

- 1) Non-itemizing individuals are eligible for a \$300 charitable deduction (\$600 for a couple) for gifts made to STR, reducing your taxable income and taxes paid.
- 2) You may be able to deduct up to 100% of your adjusted gross income (AGI) on gifts made to Strong Tower Radio or other charities. Deductible amounts are normally limited to 60% of (AGI).
- 3) The Qualified Charitable Rollovers (QCR) remain unchanged. Required minimum distributions (RMD) are waived for most qualified plan participants for tax year 2020. Even without an RMD, often qualified charitable distributions yield tax savings.
