On May 24, 1844, Samuel F.B. Morse sent the first public telegraph message quoting Numbers 23:23, “What hath God wrought?” Modern

telecommunications were built on the principles he used to communicate that message. Soon telegraph lines spanned the breadth and width of this country. Then an underwater cable was laid under the Atlantic Ocean to connect Great Britain and the rest of the world. Today we don't even think about what it takes to send a message to the next room or around the world.



Around the same time, Charles Darwin began publishing articles ‘On the Origin of Species’ which became the foundation for his work on Evolution. He felt that all animal life had common origins. Many will say modern science has its foundation built on his theories. The original title of his book hints at the accepted values held at that time, “On the Origin of Species by Means of Natural Selection, or the Preservation of Favoured Races in the Struggle for Life.”

Both men are credited for their contributions that changed the course of history forever. 

As the Israelites had to place their feet in the overflowing Jordan (See Joshua 3), so we today must learn to follow the guiding of God. It will take much sacrifice and new priorities, but what would you be willing to give up to give your kids the best life on earth and a desire for heaven?

The summer is coming to a close and if you are a parent, it's time to make decisions where to send your children to school. Change isn't easy. Making the right decision will create a myriad of challenges, but God is waiting to come alongside faithful parents and grow their faith as they disciple their children.
