Festive Holiday Salad

This salad has often been requested by our family. Its flavor, nutrition, and cheerful color keep us all coming back for more! Inspire everyone to enjoy more salad during this time of year by serving up this fun recipe or

creating a personalized version of our family favorite for yourselves.

Ingredients:

8 cups baby spinach leaves 1/2 cup pecan pieces 2 Granny Smith apples

1 large pomegranate, approx. 1 cup 1 Lime, approx. 3 Tablespoons 5 Tablespoons honey

Directions:

1. Make the dressing in a small mixing bowl by stirring the honey and lime juice together till smooth. Pour into a quart jar with a leak-proof lid. 3. Core, slice, and cut apples with skins on into 1/3-1/2-inch pieces.

4. Place apple pieces in the jar with the dressing mixture. Fasten lid and turn or shake the jar. Be sure all the apple pieces are covered, this helps with flavor and prevents discoloring from oxidation.

5. De-stem spinach leaves as desired and place in a large salad bowl. 6. You are ready to assemble the salad. Turn or shake the jar of apple pieces again, then pour 1/2 of the apple mixture over the spinach.

7. Sprinkle 1/2 the pomegranate seeds over the spinach. Using tongs, toss the spinach until it's covered with the apples and lime-honey dressing.

Then gently toss in 1/2 the pecan pieces. The nuts, seeds, and apples will tend to move to the bottom of the salad bowl. Evenly mix ingredients from top to bottom of the bowl once the dressing covers the spinach leaves.

9. Garnish the top of the salad with the remaining apples, nuts, and pomegranate seeds. If desired, hold back some pomegranate seeds and pecan pieces for garnishing if creating individual servings.

10. Note: Dressing is thin, it will cover the ingredients sufficiently; however, it will tend to go to the bottom of the bowl. Toss again before serving.

11. Alternatives/Additions: Sliced almonds, walnut pieces, dried cranberries, or cherries. Other types of apples can be used Ureated by Jodi Ferguson but do not hold up as well nor have the same sweet-tart balance for the flavors in the original recipe.

12. Makes 10 small individual salads.

To visit others and give Bible studies wasn't like it used to be. It was never convenient, but she loved the Lord too much to stop going. This wasn't just a period of a few days; this was for years.

"I want to do as much for Jesus while I can; I love Him so much," I hear her say, even now. During her last few weeks, all she could do was lay on her couch, her body begging for relief. Still, she wanted to do something for Jesus. I reminded her the most important thing she could do was to pray for others. She clung to that thought as her one desire was to do all she could for her dear Friend Jesus and share with others of His great love for them.

We all need to lovingly "submit ourselves to God" and the workings of the Holy Spirit to utterly put to death our "old man of sin" *daily!* Paul says, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved



me and gave Himself for me (<u>Gal 2:20</u>)." Our carnal nature, with its selfish and self-serving ways, must be put to DEATH! Unfortunately, our human nature is as resistant to this as Covid-19 is to modern medicine. Nevertheless, the Holy Spirit's work is to weaken our resistance to God (**Rom 5:10**).

The *convicting power of the Spirit* must soften our hardened hearts, deafened ears, blind eyes, and lack of faith with the love of God, to cultivate and bear the fruit of repentance in our lives. "The goodness of God leads us to repentance" (**Rom 2:4**). Unless the Holy Spirit is resisted, God's goodness will melt our steeled hearts like a hot knife through butter.

I remember watching "The Passion of Love" by Mel Gibson, an enactment depicting the horrifying crucifixion of Jesus. My eyes were swimming in tears most of the time as I watched. The Holy Spirit convicted me, that by my sins, I had pierced Jesus (**Zech 14:10**) when he was dying on the cross. Jesus was "made sin for us that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (**2 Cor 5:21**).

In Steps to Christ, the author says, "The battle of self is the greatest battle ever fought. The yielding of self, surrendering all to

the will of God, requires a struggle; but the soul must *submit* to God before it can be renewed in holiness" (p.33 pp 3). Repentance (*metanoia*) indicates our heart and mind have been softened and changed due to the working of the Holy Spirit. Realizing that Jesus' death on the cross



for my sins has canceled the warrant for my death (**Rom 6:23**), my stubborn heart melts. If I don't resist, the Holy Spirit will draw my heart to Jesus' heart (**Jn 12:32**), and I will confess my sins to Him and receive forgiveness and cleansing only His power alone can impart (**1 Jn 1:9**). Transformations in our character follow, another working of the Holy Spirit. Mover, Shaker, Comforter (Continued from page 9) In 2 Cor 3:18, Paul says, "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being <u>transformed</u> into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord."

Let us daily ask for the baptism of the Holy Spirit, that we yield to His convicting power, follow His leading, seek His guidance, allow Him to transform us, and bear His fruit.



Now **the birth of Jesus Christ** was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the **Holy Spirit**. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly. But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a

dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the **Holy Spirit**. And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name **Jesus**, for He will save His people from their sins." **Mt 1:18-21**


