Psalm 110:1 - (Hebrews 1:5-14) establishes that Jesus has been exalted. This gives basis for the author's statement in 2:9 "But we see Jesus . . . crowned with glory and honor."



The contradiction between Hebrews 2:8 and 2:9 - "You have put all things in subjection under his feet."(2:8) - "We do not yet see all things put under him."(2:9) is solved by Psalm 110:1.

Jesus was enthroned but according to Psalm 110:1 even after the enthronement the "enemies" are not yet all subdued.


