Churches Not to Forward Funds

The Michigan Conference of Seventh-day Adventists (SDA) recently advised local church leaders to no longer accept or remit



funds for ministries that the SDA church organization does not directly own. Whereas previously, members could give to independently owned, supportive

ministries, such as Strong Tower Radio (STR) and Amazing Facts, by including it with their tithe and offerings given in church each Sabbath. Members must now give directly to those ministries.

The reason for this change stems from a U.S. lawsuit in which the plaintiff established an agency relationship between the SDA church and a self-supporting school. Church members for years had given money for the school by including it with their tithe and offerings given to the church. The church would periodically remit the funds to the school, and the plaintiff established that the church was acting as agent of the school by collecting and remitting funds. With that agency established, the SDA church became a defendant in the lawsuit. The plaintiff ultimately won the case, and the SDA church paid several million dollars in damages.

Church members are asked to give donations to STR directly and no longer through their local church to avoid another loss from such an agency. To help with this transition, STR is sending

envelopes to the churches for members to utilize when they send checks. You may also use your bank's bill pay system to send monthly gifts to STR (check or electronic transfer) or via the STR website using a debit or credit card.
