Our last newsletter reviewed the three historical artifacts in the Ark of the Covenant (Three Angel's Messages in the Most Holy Place). Each item tells a story of God's unfathomable love and mercy. Moses demonstrated how Christ interceded on behalf of His people. When they repented, God forgave them. Each artifact has a redemptive message.

Hebrews 9:4 lists the three items from the Ark and adds a Golden Censer. The High Priest used it to burn incense while he was in the Most Holy Place. Hebrews explains that Jesus became the great High Priest when He returned to heaven after the Cross Heb. 4:14. Jesus now ministers in the Most Holy Place at the right hand of the Majesty of Heaven, God our Father Dan. 8:14 & Heb. 8:1.

God longs that we may be at peace with Him, daily coming into His presence. Sin prevents this; God constructed a way to remove sin from sinners and reinstate them as His sons and daughters through the sacrifice of His Son. He put this plan in place before there was sin.


President's Perspective "Can You Hear the Waves?"

The Lord has called us as believers to move forward in faith. To be a believer, we need to believe in something,

We cannot see the radio signal emanating from our radio antennas, but we see the effect as we tune in to the radio signal as it extends away from the radio tower. We trust that the signal will be there, even when we cannot see the radio tower. Like an unseen beacon, we can tune our radios to the proper frequency and hear the message we want to hear. Whether it is an AM or an FM station, or even WIFI or cellular, we are surprised when we cannot receive the radio signal because we assume it will be there.

I recently read a story from a newspaper published in 1969 about a ham radio operator who doubted whether NASA would actually carry the "real" conversations of the astronauts while they were on the moon. So after a lot of research, he modified some surplus radio



gear from World War II and built an antenna to tune in to the frequency of the backpack transmitters both of the astronauts would be using as they walked around on the moon.

To his delight, he was able to hear the entire conversation of both astronauts of Apollo 11 as they walked around on the moon. But his joy was short-lived when he realized he was hearing everything that the national TV

networks were airing, except he had heard it 5 seconds earlier. His wife had turned up the TV in the living room as he and a newspaper reporter adjusted the radio and tracked the moon with his antenna. You can read more detail about that story at the following website -

Jesus is the Sanctuary (Continued from page 1) However, his faithfulness to the Father demonstrated Christ's commitment to restoring humankind to His Father.

Through the Sanctuary, we follow Christ's footsteps. He draws us into the presence of our Heavenly Father, where He gives us the willingness to set aside Satan's tactics which separate us from Christ. Is there a sin in us that stands in the way of following Christ? We must



willingly let our Master Healer cut it out. Whatever keeps us from following Jesus, even if it's not a sin, must be left at the Altar of Burnt Offering, just inside the Temple Courtyard. God will not take away anything that is for our good to keep, but we cannot cling to idols in His presence.



Sin leaves stains, so we must be cleansed. Just as Jesus was baptized, we must be washed in the bronze Laver. Imagine the relief of allowing Christ to drown all of the sin-burdens in our lives! He then walks by our side all the way.

When Jesus suffered intense pangs of hunger in the wilderness, the enemy tempted Him. Christ overcame him by submitting to the Word of God, and we may gain the victory only by submission, through the merits of Christ's blood, and by the power of His life. Christ knows that we may have to fast and pray, but He will provide us with all the help we need. Thus we may be fully consecrated, like the priests of old.

Now we may follow Jesus into the Holy Place. Here we see Christ as the Light of the world,

symbolized in the Lampstand. "Thy Word is a lamp S unto my feet and a light unto my path" **Ps. 119:105**.

Christ is also symbolized as "The Bread of Life" **John 6:35**. The Lampstand and the Table of Shewbread work together like two arms. "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God" **Matt. 4:4**.

Christ's righteous intercession ascends daily like a sweet fragrance, just as the incense burnt on the Altar of Incense. Until the death of Christ, a veil closed the way into the Most Holy Place, but it was torn in two when Christ's death made a way into the presence of our heavenly Father **Matt. 27:51**. To The Mom Who Survived It All My Unsung Hero

December 30th, 1989, was when I started a journey with a mother who would someday defy all the odds! As a child, I came to respect and love you as a mother rooted in Christ. You were my protector,

supporter, and guide, and you were never hesitant to redirect me when I needed it, even if the process was difficult for you.

But, above all, you made sure I knew you believed in my potential and value.

As years passed, I watched you welcome more than 100 children into our home to live with our family. While raising five children of your own, you loved them with the same Christ-like love you showed us. You were a homeschool teacher, business owner, manager, and faithful wife. I watched as you became a prayer warrior through many of life's trials and little did you know, your example would one day have a powerful return over your own life.

In 2010, you stood by me on my wedding day, and in 2012, 2013, and 2016, you held my hand as I welcomed my children into the world. You have become my best friend, and through these milestones in my life, I made a concerted effort to be more like you!

Fast-forward to Wednesday, January 26th, 2022, one of the worst days of my life. The phone rang, it was terrible news. A horrible accident had happened. My sister and little nephew were going to be okay. As for you and 6-year-old Nora, no one knew. I was told to head for the hospital if I wanted to see you again. Nora was stabilized, and after what seemed like an eternity of hours, Dad called. "Mom coded on the table, and they are doing everything they can. They're telling me she has a less than 1% chance of survival. Pray girls... pray." Later we learned you suffered a broken clavicle, scapula, humerus, and several transverse processes in your back. Both of your lungs had



collapsed, and your ribs were shattered on both sides, along with a lacerated liver. But the most crucial was the tear in your aorta. To My Mom... (Continued from page 6)

Over the next several days, we prepared ourselves for any outcome. First, we prayed for miracles over your three major surgeries while asking for God's will. Then, one week later,



with little change, we had you anointed. This signified a crucial turning point in your recovery. The morning after the anointing, you woke up! From the moment your eyes opened, it was clear you wanted to fight to live. Another week later, we were confident we would not only have a living mom but the same sound woman we all loved, respected, and had prayed for since that terrible day. Doctors estimated a five-week stay at the hospital, then a transfer to Mary Free Bed Rehab for six weeks of therapy and pain management. But you and God had other plans!

Only four weeks after the accident, you returned home to heal alongside the support of family and friends. Although you still fight a daily battle to overcome trials, your strength and bravery are an encouragement to everyone around you.

I will forever be grateful to have the honor of being called your



daughter. I count it an incredible blessing to have my mom still present as an amazing example of perseverance and love in my life today. With the most sincere gratitude and awe, I continue to testify of God's fulfilled faithfulness through His presence in your life and mine. He who had raise started a good work in you was not quite finished writing


your story yet. Your journey is nothing short of amazing. With God, you beat the odds, mom. You are my unsung hero, the mom who survived. You refused to let anyone or anything stop you from living for Jesus today and every day. You are the definition of the word miracle. I love you and am so proud of you.





understanding. Sidney's sister Emily, who is three years her elder, introduced a classmate named Ryan to Sidney, and their friendship steadily developed from that point. Sidney would go to church with Ryan and his family, and she enjoyed the experience through high school and even college.

Shortly after Ryan graduated college, Sidney noticed that he began tuning the car radio to Strong Tower Radio whenever they would drive somewhere, such as dinner or another commuter event. He would also use the STR broadcast to start conversations on a Bible topic, asking her questions connected to the broadcast.

Ryan started Bible studies with the Cedar Lake Seventh-day Adventist Church pastor in the fall of 2019, and Sidney began thinking, "where's this going, and where's our life going together?" She concluded that "if I want to grow spiritually and as a person, I also need to study the Bible!" Ryan had listened to STR for years by this time, and Sidney wanted to know more. So she began listening to STR programs, including Your Story Hour, Bible Answers Live, and various sermons, and found STR an excellent tool to learn the Scriptures.


