The radio wasn't picking up the local station a few miles away, but STR came in clearly on 97.9 FM, WIHC. Staci was a skeptic at the time, and one of the first programs she heard was Bible Answers Live with Doug Batchelor and Jean Ross. She determined to pick



Answers Live apart all that they said and prove it false. This desire prompted her to listen to more STR programs to nitpick more of what she heard! She listened at work, then added her commute

and her listening escalated over a 3-year period.

Staci went from listening to pick apart what she heard to just listening to learn. She couldn't get enough! The Lord blessed her with a new position at work, in an office instead of by the saws and heavy equipment, and she could better hear the broadcast.

Staci began to desire a church family where she could receive the truth instead of mixing traditions with some truth, as in her past experiences. She wanted a church Welcome where she could hear the truth like on STR, a place To Our where she could learn, grow, and experience joy!

One day, while working, Staci was listening to an STR program that she found intensely interesting. Or Isaiah who quotes the Lord saying, "I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams... I do not delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs or goats... I cannot endure iniquity and the sacred meeting. Your New Moons and your appointed feasts My soul hates... I am weary of bearing them... Even though you make many prayers, I will not hear. Your hands are full of blood... Cease to do evil, learn to do good..." Isa 1:11-17


