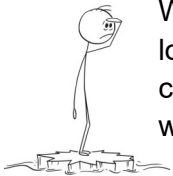

Now We Have a Family

Tyler Cunningham and his mom, Dawn Gallant, have experienced many trials, yet through it all, Jesus lifted them high. Tyler wanted to study vocal music at a nearby Michigan university and worked toward that end, gaining a scholarship. His mom, Dawn, helped him with tuition his first year, then lost her employment. At 14, Dawn gave her heart to Jesus in response to an appeal at a Protestant church she attended. Into adulthood, she drifted away amid life's bustle yet often prayed for God's guidance/help. She took her job loss to God and prayed, "God, I don't know what to do. Show me what to do, and I'll do it." He did. Working through circumstances, God brought jobs to Dawn, particularly in home health care, and she was able to cover another year of tuition toward Tyler's vocal training.

That last semester was a rough one for Tyler, and as a result, he lost his scholarship. He worked through the summer toward tuition costs, yet the back pain he'd been experiencing worsened with the physical work that he was doing, even producing leg numbness and weakness.

With his worsening health and the added cost of the lost scholarship, Tyler decided not to return to the university that Fall. He told Dawn that the world needs skilled trades and enrolled at the local community college.

The back pain intensified, then 3 days into his first trade school semester, Tyler found out that his mom had cancer! More prayer! Surgery resolved the cancer problem, praise God!

Soon afterward, Tyler was diagnosed with Congenital Spinal Stenosis, a condition where the inside diameter of the vertebrae is smaller than average and often causes spinal compression and nerve pain. Years of pain medication and physical therapy followed prior to Tyler opting for surgery. He reached that decision during the COVID-19 quarantine period, and he waited nine months to have the surgery at the University of Michigan Hospital. Dawn had to drop him off at the front door, and there was no visitation.



After the surgery, the surgeon stated that "Tyler has a very small spine for an average-sized person, let alone someone 6'3" and over 225 lbs!" By day 5, Tyler was able to walk to the end of the hall at the hospital, and so they discharged him to go home.

A bright spot of this trying time was all the Christian people that they knew - more than 100 - praying for him through the entire experience, powering him through the surgery, and being able to heal at home. Both Dawn and Tyler wanted to thank God for His provision personally, by attending church locally. The church to visit remained the question.

Five years prior, Dawn's friend Linda had invited Dawn to attend church with her: Now Dawn called Linda to accept that invitation, much to Linda's joyful surprise! Linda had recently begun to attend a different church, the Houghton Lake Seventh-day Adventist church, as a result of their kindness in praying for and serving her sister Sharon during the illness and subsequent death of her husband, Jeff. Dawn and Tyler attended with Linda, and as soon as they walked in, they felt like they were part of the church family. Upon returning the following week, walking with the assistance of a cane, Tyler sang special music, "How Great Thou Art," and gave praise to God.

Several church members introduced Dawn and Tyler to Strong Tower Radio (STR) and 3ABN, saying, "you want to listen to/watch these" and "they were so right," Dawn affirms. In the year following their visit, they studied the Bible with head elder Kevin Jacobs and then publicly embraced the everlasting gospel of Jesus Christ, signifying with baptism on August 27, 2022.



At Houghton Lake SDA church, Dawn and Tyler are part of an active, loving family. "We went from feeling like we had almost no family to having a great big family! It's very encouraging to have like-minded people who seek God and live by His Word."

"Now we only listen to STR!" Dawn says. "The programs are so helpful to us, and sometimes I even sit in the store parking lot to finish the story or sermon on the broadcast."

Friends, this is another way STR has a powerful impact on listeners. Not all discover STR as a point of first contact with the everlasting gospel. Some discover it after they've entered an SDA church via some other influence, and members share STR with them. The broadcast becomes a teaching companion, instructing and affirming what the exploring guests learn in church and later Bible study. Glory to God for more changed and changing lives!
